

#### **Application process**

In your MyEAN account (my.ean.org) you can either apply for membership, or upgrade your current one. The system will automatically select the right type of membership for you, based on the application form. Please upload your CV and any other required documents to complete the application.

#### What documents to submit

Please upload your CV and the following documents, based on your membership:

- Fellow of EAN application
  - a cover letter detailing your important achievements and a list of publications
- Resident & Research Membership application
  - an official confirmation/certification of your (ongoing) training in neurology or PhD studies in English
- Student Membership application
  - a brief explanation of your special interest in neurology and the reason for requesting membership and your student ID

#### Who reviews your application

Full, Corresponding and FEAN applications are reviewed by the EAN Secretary General. RRFS and Student applications are reviewed by the RRFS Secretary.

#### Membership renewal

Your EAN membership can be conveniently renewed at the start of each calendar year in your MyEAN profile.
